General 4-H Animal Science Short Term Volunteer Opportunities

Maryland 4-H is always looking for willing volunteers and employees to help with state activities and events throughout the year around Maryland. State event volunteers work short term with groups of youth under the supervision of UME volunteers or paid UME employees. It is recommended that volunteers be current UME volunteers, however, short-term volunteers with animal science knowledge and/or previous 4-H event experience are also welcome to assist. Volunteers who spend overnight with youth as chaperones are required to be UME volunteers.
