Equal Access Programs

Eligibility

- Be a currently enrolled 4-H member who has completed at least two (2) years of 4-H work in Maryland

OR

- Is a Maryland 4-H Alumni(ae) having been enrolled in Maryland 4-H for a minimum of two (2) years prior to graduating from 4-H

Application Requirements

- Candidates submitting a Maryland 4-H Foundation Scholarship Award Application must be planning to enroll in an accredited college, university or post high school program in the fall of the year in which the application is made.
- Scholarship award applications are to be postmarked by June 1st of the year in which the scholarship application is made.
- The Scholarship Award Application must be type written or filled out in black ink and signed by the candidate.
- Candidates must provide documentation as to:
 - o Financial need
 - o High School Scholastic Record/ Unofficial transcript from post-high school institution
 - o Leadership Abilities and resourcefulness
 - o 4-H Background
 - o A letter of recommendation from high school counselor, county/city 4-H educator, or college advisor
 - o Special Criteria for selected Scholarships
 - **J. O'Neal & Rosa Moxley Johnston Memorial Scholarship-** applicant must attend the University of Maryland, College Park.
 - **W. Lawson King Memorial Scholarship-** applicant must be enrolled in an Agriculture-related curriculum
 - **William E. and Eileen M. Klingelhofer Memorial Scholarship-** applicant must be an entering freshman
 - **Brenda Bourne Stair Memorial Scholarship-** applicant must have demonstrated record of leadership and citizenship abilities and activities
 - **Irene G. & Nicholas A. Porter Memorial Scholarship-** applicant must be enrolled in a horticulture/plant science related curriculum

Selection Process

Upon receipt of all complete applications, a committee composed of the Maryland 4-H Foundation Board of Directors will review all applications and select qualified recipients and alternates. All committee decisions are final. Winners will be notified by October 1. Applications missing required information will NOT be reviewed.

Award Process

Academic Scholarship Award winners will receive their scholarship payment in full at the 2011 Maryland 4-H Gala, Sunday January 15, 2012, Ten Oaks Ballroom, Clarksville, MD, individual or family representative must attend (special exceptions allowed). Winner must provide the Foundation with a signed acceptance form and copy of their student schedule prior to receiving an award check.
