Teen Council members are called on to represent Maryland 4-H at statewide programs and events, including but not limited to Maryland Day at the University of Maryland College Park, the Maryland State Fair, 4-H Foundation meetings, and State 4-H Awards and Recognition programs. Serving on the State 4-H Teen Council is an opportunity for leadership development, meeting 4-H teens from across Maryland, and creating new possibilities for 4-H youth development program.
